Burton-upon-Trent (led by John Miller)

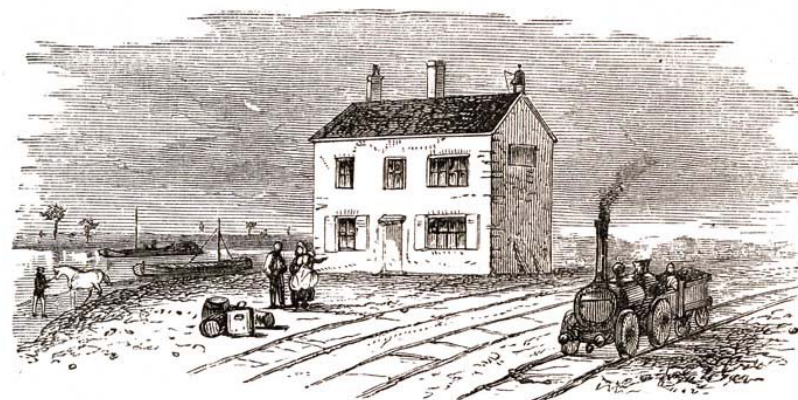
A station or two, plus a couple of canals, and a dozen or so loco sheds, 40 level crossings and at least 100 signal boxes
